To provide quality cricket opportunities and experiences for all levels of cricketers to participate, enjoy and progress in the game within a well organised and supportive club with excellent facilities

Club Structure

In 2022 High School Old Boys' Collegians Cricket Club (OBC) is one of the largest cricket clubs in NZ with over 600 players, comprising 59 teams – 13 senior (10 men, 3 women) and 46 junior teams, catering for men, women and children of all ages, abilities and interests. The Club was formed in 2004, following the amalgamation of two prominent Christchurch clubs – HSOB and Old Collegians – both having their origins in the 1920s. Historically, before the merger, each of these clubs had strong links with traditional cricketing schools, namely: Christchurch Boys' High School, Christ's College and St Andrew's College.

The Club is located in the heart of Merivale at picturesque Elmwood Park, where it has three turf pitches, and a newly constructed artificial practice facility and state-of-the-art pavilion. The Club uses professional coaches who provide a well organised junior player focused coaching programme and a 'ages and stages' playing pathway.

The Club's adult teams have had considerable success in the Christchurch Metro Cricket competitions, and a number of its individual players selected to represent Canterbury and New Zealand. In 2018, OBC received the 'Club of the Year' at the Canterbury Sports Awards for its contribution to the community.

Key Goals 2022-2024

To ensure good governance throughout the club, and to increase the inclusion of all members and supporters within the club and improve communication.

To establish strong and sustainable links with specific schools and the broader community as a means of retaining former OBC Junior players, and recruiting new players to ensure the club's future sustainability.

Provide a structure that ensures a good number and quality of coaches through identification, guidance, education, support and recognition.

To support the Junior coaching and playing philosophy of 'Balance is Better' and deliver children-focused fun programmes that give everyone a reasonable opportunity to enjoy the game and learn skills no matter their abilities.


How far you go, depends on attitude and the grass at Elmwood Park is not a bad place to start

The Club supplied 4 players to the Canterbury Magicians team - Allie Mace-Cochrane, Missy Banks, Emma Kench and Abby Gerken, as well as Lucy Boucher from Northern Districts, and Monique Rees from Central Districts. Missy Banks and Abby Gerken picked up Canterbury Cricket awards in recognition of their efforts. We also had two U19 reps – Fanchea Molony and Niamh McKenzie.

The Premier team had some mixed results throughout the season but did finish the season on a high, picking up the One Day title - something that has eluded us for 7 years, despite being in numerous finals, so it was very pleasing to finally get this across the line. We are very thankful to our U19 girls who performed excellently when called on to fill in when we had players away on rep duties.

Last season, we fielded our first Div1/Under 19 side and fielded the U16's with the bare minimum number of players. The U19 team was very competitive throughout the season, despite the demands of having to provide players to Pregs on a regular basis, and our U16's have set a fantastic foundation for next season as they look to continue to grow as cricketers.

CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

Aim: Provide high quality cricket experience which is fun and provides a high level of technical training to develop players skills in a safe environment. This code of conduct must be adhered for the benefit of everyone.

All players, umpires, managers, coaches, parents and spectators should:

- Respect the rules
- Respect the officials and accept their decisions
- Respect the opponent
- Have a concern for equal opportunity
- Be gracious winners and dignified losers

As Players

- Co-operate with others and treat them with respect
- Have fun, develop your own skills while accepting your limits
- Know the rules and don't cheat
- Accept the Umpire's decision without dissent, even if you do not think they're right
- Don't use coarse language

As Parents and Spectators

- Every player is required to be supervised by their appropriate adult at games
- Never force children to participate - only encourage
- Don't achieve your dreams by pressuring a child
- Talk to your child/player in an encouraging way. Are they having fun?
- Are they learning that being fair and developing new skills are important?
- Do not encroach onto the playing area

Junior Training sessions run at Elmwood Park:

Punctuality

Please arrive prompt for the start of your session. Wait at the front of the pavilion until your coach comes over. Note that coaches maybe training another group directly before your session, please do not disturb them.

Behaviour

- Respect your coach and your team mates
- Disruptive behaviour is not acceptable for the sake of others
- Unacceptable behaviour will not be tolerated, such as play fighting, bullying etc.
- Listen at all times to your coach, no talking when they are talking.
- No defiance.
- Unacceptable language including swearing is not to be used at any time.

Safety

- During coaching session players are supervised by club coaches, but appropriate adults are responsible for their own children before and after this time or if there is a behaviour issue.
- Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times, no jandals or bare feet at anytime.
- It is compulsory for any children using hardballs, when batting and wicket keeping up to the stumps to wear a helmet and box along with the normal protective equipment.
- Only players being coached by club coaches are allowed in the enclosed nets 3.30-6.30 Monday-Friday
- You must inform the coach of any injuries before and during the session. First aid and ice is provided. Accident report forms may need to be filled in.
- Once the session has finished coach's move into the next group, anyone waiting for parents must wait in front of the pavilion. No child waiting is the responsibility of the coach.

Facilities & Equipment

- Treat with care the facility and equipment. Any damage will be chargeable.
- All equipment is to be returned to its proper place after use.
- Bring your own drinking bottle, drinking water is available at the front of the pavilion.
- Gear bags are not to be left on the path please put these on the grass outside the nets.
- No muddy shoes in the pavilion area or nets.
- There is a toilet available please ask the coach and leave it clean and tidy.

Wet Weather

- In the event of rain, we may try and run an indoor session in the pavilion if available. Please check www.facebook.com/OBCCJuniors we aim to post around lunchtime through to the start of the session.
